Climber rescued after 60-ft fall on Yak Peak

On July 12, two alpine rock climbers were rescued off Yak Peak, above the Coquihalla Highway, after one of the climbers took a 60-foot fall. They were on the popular Yak Check, a 12-pitch 5.10a (considered intermediate on the scale of rock climbing difficulty).

Chilliwack and Hope Search and Rescues responded to the call about a climber "who sustained injuries while leading the sixth pitch. The injury was too severe to rappel, so they called 911. The sixth-pitch of Yak Check is a 55-metre 5.8 that follows flakes into bulges with some chossy rock."

Two search and rescue techs performed a technical longline rescue with Valley Helicopters. The two climbers were airlifted to a staging area below before the injured climber was taken to hospital in an ambulance.

Federal assistance for wildfires

Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness Bowinn Ma said yesterday that "... this fire season has been one of the most challenging and persistent on record. Although we are still early in the fire season, it has already proven to be a difficult time for communities, First Nations, people living in the affected areas and BC Wildfire Service firefighters." Especially after the death of 2 wildland firefighters this past week.

Minister Ma made a request to federal Minister Bill Blair for federal assistance to support the BC response. The federal government quickly approved the request and deployed the Canadian Armed Forces and the Canadian Coast Guard to aid in suppressing wildfires.

These federal resources will join teams from Australia, as well as more than 350 international personnel currently in place in BC from the U.S., Mexico and New Zealand. These teams work alongside the approximate 2,000 BC Wildfire Service personnel across the province.

Mining in Merritt

The Middlesboro Colliery, of the Nicola Valley Coal and Coke Company, was located about one mile south of Merritt, and was the most important coal property. It was comprised of a large surface plant, consisting of mine yards, a large screening plant with bunkers, a steam power plant, machine shops and a townsite. Middlesboro was connected to the Kettle Valley Railway by a branch line. Middlesboro Collieries went through some very tough times in the 30s, and were often open only one or two days a week. In 1944, Middlesboro coal properties changed hands and became the Coldwater Colliery, which remained open until 1963, after which there was no further demand for coal.

Diamond Vale Coal and Iron Mines Ltd, later know as Diamond Vale Collieries Ltd., was reincorporated in 1902. This property lies immediately east of the Middlesboro Collieries, the Coldwater River forming the boundary between them. This company never really got out of the development stage, and after an explosion in 1912 in which 7 people died, the mine — faced with many court actions — never got back on its feet.

Coal Hill Syndicate, also know as Inland Coal and Coke, changed owners many times over the years. In 1918 it became known as the Fleming Coal Company, and in 1924 it became the Keystone Coal Company Ltd. Coal Hill was located west of and about 500 feet higher than the Middlesboro Colliery. Coal Hill remained open until 1927.

Coal mining is a big part of the area's history, and although its role was diminishing, it played an important role in the survival of the people of Merritt during the receivership (April 1933-December 1951).

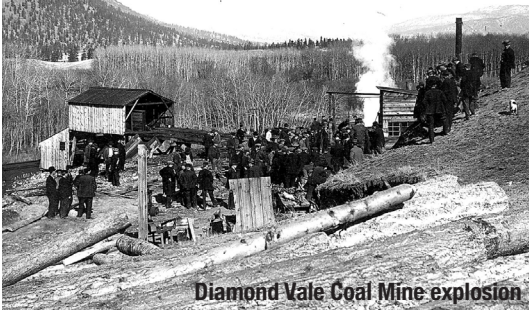

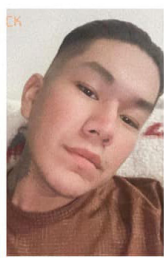
