

## **Ross Moore Lake** wildfire

The Kamloops Fire Centre recorded 628 lightning strikes as of midnight on July 20. Since then, several new fires have started, due to the lightning activity.

The Ross Moore Lake fire was discovered Friday, July 21, just before 2pm, 24km south of Kamloops between Hwy 5 & Hwy 5. Later that afternoon it grew to 20 hectares, out of control.

Saturday it was mapped at 700 hectares, burning at rank 4, and a heavy equipment task force was activated. Overnight, it more than doubled to 1,800 hectares, to become a 'fire of note'.

Kamloops first put out an evacuation alert for Knutsford, then TNRD issued an evacuation order yesterday at 7:30pm for the areas south of Kamloops; east of Highway 5; north of Stump Lake; and west of Roche Lake. They say the fire poses a threat to life and property for approximately 344 addressed properties in the area.

A lightning-cause fire found Friday afternoon east of Stump Lake is being held at 4.45 hectares.






