IIO investigating accident in Logan Lk with Merritt connection

The Independent Investigations Office (IIO) of BC is investigating a motor vehicle incident in Logan Lake where 3 people died.

Information provided by the RCMP states that at about 6:25am on July 23, police received a call from staff at the Best Western in Merritt as they reported that a man had damaged a hotel room and they sought assistance in having him leave. The man was reportedly cooperative collected his belongings and departed at about 10am after speaking to police.

At about 11:30am the same day, the man was involved in a fatal 2-vehicle collision on Highway 97D outside of Logan Lake. Three people died in the collision — the man police spoke to in Merritt, and the driver and passenger of the other vehicle.

The IIO was notified of the incident shortly after the collision occurred. Initial investigative steps will seek to confirm what role, if any, police actions or inactions may have played in the collision.

Wildfire update

Over the weekend, 102 additional wildfire fighters from Brazil arrived in BC. They will be supporting firefighting efforts in the Cariboo Fire Centre. The current firefighting effort across our province consists of approx. 600 out-of-country resources, and over 2,000 BCWS staff members — as well as support from local community contractors, including heavy equipment operators, first aid attendants, food suppliers and many others.

Weather

This weekend's precipitation was not substantial enough to negate drought conditions. Significant lightning was received over the weekend, 39,260 lightning strikes were recorded in BC since Friday.

Moving forward Environment Canada is predicting the same trend of warm and dry conditions in the southern regions of the province with no precipitation anticipated in the near future. A significant concern will be overnight recoveries and crossover conditions, where the relative humidity of an area falls below the temperature of an area. They are expecting some windy conditions in the coming days and some rain for the northwest regions of the province.

Working to get hay to farmers

The Ministry of Agriculture and Food is working with partners to support BC farmers and ranchers who are facing challenges due to the current shortage of hay and feed across Western Canada.

To help farmers and producers get hay and feed, the ministry is funding a new Access to Feed program that will be delivered in partnership with the BC Cattlemen's Association (BCCA). Through this program, the BCCA will match sellers of hay and feed domestically across Canada and internationally with farmers and producers.

The governments of Canada and BC are working together to strengthen existing support programs to help farmers and ranchers with the cost of hay and feed, which is currently higher than usual due to ongoing drought conditions throughout Western Canada. Immediate supports are available through the federal-provincial AgriStability program to help producers with drought or wildfire-related income declines.

BC is currently facing a severe drought situation with more than two-thirds of B.C.'s water basins at Drought Level 4 or Drought Level 5. As drought conditions worsen, with unprecedented levels of drought seen in British Columbia this early in the season, people and businesses are urged to prioritize water conservation.
