Fire in woodchip pile

While there's at least one every summer, Saturday's woodchip pile fire on the old Tolko site drew out fire departments from surrounding communities — Kelowna, Logan lake, Peachland, Lake Country, Williams Lake, Princeton, BX & Swan Lake, and Penticton — as well as BC Wildfire Service with 6 skimmers (picking up water from Nicola Lake) & at least 2 helicopters (picking up water on the Nicola River west of town).

The fire was reported at about 1:30pm, and the first Voyent alert was sent out 4:40pm. A second notice reported someone flying a drone over the fire area. Water drops were paused for a few minutes while the drone cleared out.

Ground crews worked through the night and the fire was under control yesterday afternoon. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

Author talk with Nicola I. Campbell

Toxins in algae blooms at Nicola, Douglas & Chapperon lakes

Interior Health is advising people who use N'Kwala (Nicola) Lake, Spaxomin (Douglas) Lake and/or Chapperon Lake that there is a risk of exposure to cyanobacterial toxin due to the presence of blue-green algae blooms on these lakes.


Water samples taken on July 26 from each lake tested positive for the cyanobacterial toxin. Cyanobacteria can produce several types of toxin that can be poisonous to people, pets and livestock.

Exposure to cyanobacteria toxin can occur through ingestion of or contact with contaminated water. Lake users are advised to not use the water in these lakes at this time.

Algae blooms can remain in a water body for weeks to months. Once the bloom is no longer present and two consecutive sets of samples do not show the presence of cyanobacteria toxin, Interior Health will review any beach closures and /or advisories.
