

6 years for inquest to be scheduled in **2017** death

The death of Heather Louise Cote, 60, was reported to the BC Coroners Service by Merritt RCMP while she was in their custody, on Aug. 26, 2017. At the time, the Independent Investigations Office of B.C., the province's police watchdog, looked into the death and closed it without a public report.

No further details related to the circumstances of Cote's death are available.

The BC Coroners Service will hold an inquest into her death, beginning on Sept. 18, 9:30am. at the Kelowna Law Courts.






