Toxic algae bloom advisory lifted at Nicola Lake

On Friday, Interior Health removed the toxic algae bloom advisory for N'Kwala (Nicola) Lake.

Recent water samples taken by BC Parks at Monck Park have tested negative for the presence of cyanobacterial toxin. Lake users should use caution if they see signs of an algae bloom. It is best to avoid contact with an algae bloom and if contact is made, rinse your body with clean water.

First Nations Health Authority continues to monitor the northeast side of the lake as well as Douglas and Chaperon lakes.

Roger Sloan took a huge step toward returning to the PGA Tour by winning the Korn Ferry Tour's Utah Championship on Sunday. He shot 5-under 66. Sloan, who lost his PGA Tour card after the 2021-22 season, is now 27th on the Korn Ferry points list this season. The top 30 at season's end graduate to the PGA Tour. There are 5 events left on the Korn Ferry schedule this season.

Property tax sale

Parcels of property with unpaid delinquent taxes will be offered for sale by public auction unless the taxes with interest are paid by September 22, 2023 — as per the Local Government Act (RSBC 2015) Part 16, Division 7. The auction will take place at 10 am, on the last Monday in September each year in Council Chambers, at City Hall.

The City is required to advertise and conduct a tax sale on all properties that taxes have not been paid for 3 years. Property owners with delinquent taxes are notified directly and must pay their taxes a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the tax sale date. A list of the delinquent properties will be posted early September. If all delinquent property taxes are fully paid, the auction will be cancelled.

After the sale, the original owner has one year after the property is sold to pay the taxes and buy back their property — this is called redemption. FMI on all the property tax rules, visit merritt.ca/property-tax.

Medal of Good Citizenship

Nominations are open for the Province's Medal of Good Citizenship for 2023. This prestigious medal recognizes people who, through exceptional long-term service, have made outstanding contributions to their communities without expectation of remuneration or reward. These contributions are outside of paid employment or go beyond the parameters of what their job entails.

The medal acknowledges their generosity, service, acts of selflessness and contributions to community life. Any current or former long-term resident of British Columbia is eligible to be nominated for the medal. Youth aged 15-25 and posthumous nominations are also welcome.

Nominations are due by Monday, Sept. 4, 2023, to be considered this year. Submissions received after this date will be considered for 2024. Nomination forms and the criteria to apply are available online: www.gov.bc.ca/medalofgoodcitizenship

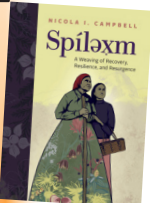
