**Provincial wildfire** update

Since April 1, 2023, 1,754 wildfires have burned about 1.58 million hectares of land in BC. There are currently 397 active fires burning across the province.

Cooler weather and precipitation continued to dampen fire activity in many regions of the province this week.

The prevailing pattern is expected to end this weekend when an offshore ridge will build towards the coast bringing higher temperatures to the Interior and coastal regions.

# **Emergency** communication & evacuation funding

Among the 19 communities with emergency-evacuation-route plans &/or public-notification plans that will be funded by the Province, are two local projects: Nooaitch Indian Band's emergency communication & evacuation route plan (receiving \$25,000); and TNRD's evacuation route review (receiving \$27,625).

More than \$880,000 is being provided through the Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) to communities to develop and update such plans,.

In February, the Province provided \$180 million to CEPF, bringing the total provincial investment in the program to \$369 million since its establishment in 2017. The CEPF is administered by the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM) on behalf of the Province.




