Kookipi Creek in Nahatlach Park, near Boston Bar, 45 minutes north of Hope

The wildfire responsible for the huge swath of smoke & blood-red sunset yesterday in the Nicola Valley is at Kookipi Creek in Nahatlach Park near Boston Bar. It was mapped at 2000 hectares (at 10:30pm Thursday evening), and is considered 'Out of Control'. It is continuing to spread and is not responding to suppression efforts.

And with instability near and behind the cold front that came in overnight, the main hazard is localized severe winds with speeds up to or above 70 km/h and dry lightning (lightning that comes with little or no rain). Drought-stricken trees will be more susceptible to winds.

Level 5 watering restrictions now in effect

Level 5 watering restrictions define NO LAWN WATERING and NO GAR-DEN SPRINKLERS. Flowers, trees, and shrubs can no longer be watered using potable City water. Residents may collect grey water, such as when washing dishes, to use for non-food-producing outdoor plants.

Only VEGETABLE gardens and fruit trees can be HANDWATERED with a hose with an automatic shut-off valve or by drip irrigation system.

OUTDOOR WASHING is NOT PER-MITTED unless ordered by a regulatory authority. Washing vehicle windows is permitted for safety reasons. Commercial car washes remain open.

Pools and hot tubs can NOT be topped up or filled.

Bulk water usage is NOT PERMIT-TED, with the exception of drinking water. Key FOBs will be turned off.




