City of Merritt emergency support

The City of Merritt is working closely with the Central Okanagan Regional District to provide emergency supports during their wildfire emergency. Because of limited resources, people should only come to Merritt if they are under evacuation order and have been directed to come here by their local ESS centres.

Mayor Goetz said: "We are very grateful for the assistance provided to the City of Merritt during our 2021 flood evacuation and we would love to return the favour. We have limited resources, but we have been in contact with all impacted communities, and we will do what we can to support our neighbouring regions."

The City of Merritt is not accepting donations at this time. If you wish to support the evacuees, we recommend donating to organizations like the Red Cross, United Way, or a food bank in the affected area.

State of emergency & travel restrictions

On Friday, the Province of BC declared a Provincial State of Emergency to support ongoing response and recovery efforts caused by wildfire. This declaration allows the Province to enact Emergency Orders, including travel restrictions to specific areas as needed.

Non-essential use of temporary accommodations is restricted, including hotels, motels, inns, bed and breakfasts, hostels, RV parks, and campgrounds, in these Okanagan cities: Kelowna & West Kelowna, Kamloops, Oliver, Osoyoos, Penticton & Vernon.

The restrictions will support access to accommodations for evacuees and personnel providing emergency and critical services. Check drivebc.ca for highway closures & travel advisories.

This Order will remain in effect until end of day September 4, 2023.

As of yesterday, Kelowna Int'l Airport was still closed to support aerial firefighting efforts. The Kamloops and Penticton airports are still open for essential travel.

"Wildfires no risk to pipeline operations"

Trans Mountain said yesterday that the BC wildfires posed no risk to its pipeline operations or its expansion project.

Trans Mountain said that they maintain several wildfire equipment trailers and caches of equipment that allows for the safe construction and operation of the pipeline adding that underground pipelines are buried a few feet below the surface and are protected from the fire by the soil and constant movement of liquid moving through the pipelines.

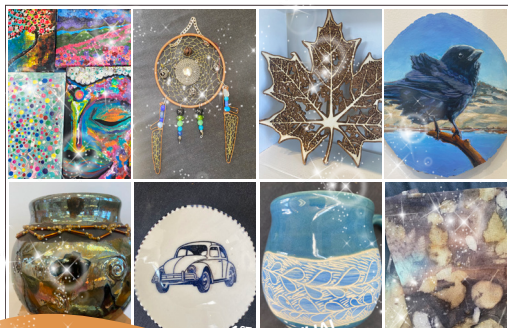
