Rodeo parade The rodeo parade kicks off the long weekend this evening, at 6:30pm — it's back after a few years hiatus, with an evening format! It will follow the same route as the grad parade, assembling on Canford Ave. , winding through downtown.

The dance will be held at the Civic Centre on Saturday evening, starting at 7pm, featuring Bobby Garcia and Six More Strings, age 19+. Greg Lewis leaves Merritt for TNRD

TNRD has announced that Merritt's Director of Corporate Services, Greg Lewis, has been hired as their new Gen. Manager of Corporate & Legislative Services.

He has worked in local government administration for the City of Merritt since 2019, where he served in several roles including Interim Chief Administrative Officer, Corporate Officer, Chief Election Officer, and head of Merritt's Emergency Operations Centre during the November 2021 floods.

Greg will take over the position beginning in late September. He follows Scott Hildebrand, who left a couple years ago to fill TNRD's top spot.

Province extends state of emergency

With continued fire risk in many regions, and tens of thousands of people still under evacuation order and alert, the Province is extending the provincial state of emergency until Sept. 14, to ensure public safety and support the response to B.C.'s worst-ever wildfire season.

Recent rain provided some relief to southern & coastal regions. However, northern BC is expected to continue to see unseasonably warm temperatures, dry conditions, smoke & strong winds, which could lead to extreme fire behaviour. In addition to 4,200 people on evacuation order, nearly 65,000 additional people remain on evacuation alert & ready to leave their homes at a moment's notice.

There are more than 3,500 personnel directly engaged in wildfire response efforts, including BC Wildfire Service staff, contract personnel and personnel from Mexico, South Africa, Australia, Ontario and the Canadian Armed Forces.

Min. of Transp. & Infrastructure cautions drivers to expect delays on the Coquihalla with 70km/hr construction speed zones in place at the Bottletop, Juliet and Jessica bridges. Prepare for changes in speed limits & drive with caution.
