Edison Motors' hybrid electric/diesel logging truck

Edison Motors will unveil their prototype for a hybrid electric/diesel truck at Vancouver's *Fully Charged LIVE* event, billed as the world's no.1 home energy & electric vehicle show, on at the Vancouver Convention Centre this weekend.



Edison Motors' hybrid truck promises more horsepower with a fraction of the fuel costs and emissions.

Because of range limitations, [Edison Motors president Chase] Barber said fully electric trucks only work for about 10% of the industry. He believes his hybrid model is the answer for most of the rest.

"We have made the first two real pure diesel/electric hybrid trucks in North America," said Barber. "We can tackle that other 80% of the electrification that full-electric doesn't." — kamloopsbcnow.com

He's referring to the 1962 Kenworth Logging truck that the company was retrofitting last year. Now they have their own design for a new hybrid work truck, designed by their crew of loggers & mechanics.

Pan-grilled chicken with fresh plum salsa

2 cups chopped ripe plums

1 small jalapeno pepper, seeded and diced

2 tablespoons chopped fresh basil

2 tablespoons chopped red onion

2 teaspoons fresh lime juice

3/4 teaspoon salt, divided

2 tablespoons brown sugar

1/2 teaspoon ground cumin

4 (4-oz.) chicken breast cutlets

2 teaspoons olive oil



Stir together plums, next 4 ingredients, and 1/4 tsp. salt in a medium bowl.

Stir together brown sugar, cumin, and remaining 1/2 tsp. salt in a small bowl. Rub chicken with brown sugar mixture.

Cook chicken in hot oil in a grill pan or nonstick skillet over medium heat 3 minutes on each side or until done. Serve with plum mixture.
