

Maggie, the beaver

A couple of weeks ago, after months of rehabilitation at the Interior Wildlife Rehabilitation Society in Kelowna, Maggie the beaver returned to the wild. Maggie's solitary rehabilitation journey was unusual because beavers typically live in pairs or in established colonies.

Maggie was found alone in the wild in June, suffering from several open wounds. Recognizing her need for immediate care, wildlife biologist Tom Willms arranged her transport to the rehabilitation centre.

The wildlife federation took a keen interest in her rehabilitation because of the crucial role she could play in the restoration of wetlands. The Federation is building more than 100 structures across BC designed to mimic beaver dams, which provide flood and flow mitigation on creeks.

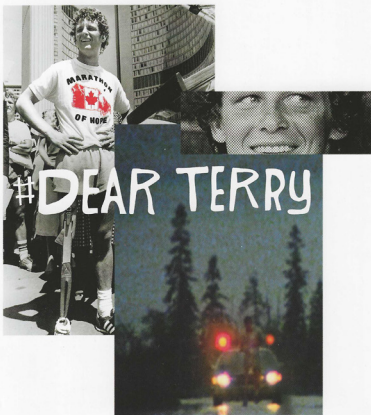
