

Province must take responsibility for flood protection infrastructure

In the wake of the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives' recent report on the state of dikes in Merritt, Princeton & Abbotsford, the organization is calling on the province to:

 Assume authority for all dikes, which hundreds of local government representatives attending the Union of BC Municipalities annual convention endorsed in 2014 and 2015 and again in 2022 following the floods in November 2021 that devastated First Nation communities, the cities of Merritt and Abbotsford and the Town of Princeton.

•Increase and dedicate provincial funding to upgrade structurally unsound or insufficient dikes, based on an assessment of those dikes most at risk.

• Authorize a review by the Auditor Gen. of the province's regulation of dikes.

"Given that provincial dike inspectors work for the Ministry of Forests and the ministry also has responsibility for dams, logging, fighting wildfires and for providing early and effective warnings about imminent floods, we believe the Auditor General would perform a valuable public service by reviewing how these officials exercise their regulatory powers within their own spheres but also how they coordinate with one another," CCPA-BC resource policy analyst Ben Parfitt said.
