Special weather statement last night

Yesterday, Environment Canada issued a special weather statement, for the possibility of snow on the Okanagan Connector overnight. "A low pressure system will spread precipitation to the southern interior overnight. Freezing levels will lower tonight to close to 1700 metres allowing the precipitation to possibly fall as snow over Pennask Summit on Highway 97C. Snowfall amounts of 2 to 4 cm are possible near the summit by Wednesday morning."

Two fires put out over the weekend

20km south of Merritt on the Coq
A group of passersby jumped into action Friday evening after coming upon a fire burning on the side of the Coquihalla Highway.

Alyshia and Ken Ahner were driving from the Okanagan to the coast Friday at about 6pm when they came upon a fire burning on the side of the Coquihalla, about 20 kilometres south of Merritt. A single RCMP officer was on scene working to prevent the fire from spreading.

They pulled over and a superintendent for Kilawna Builders Ltd., grabbed some shovels from the back of his truck and went to help. He shovelled dirt on the fire until more people showed up.

Six Emil Anderson trucks pulled over, coming off shift change. They had fire extinguishers and equipment.

A couple pulling a camping trailer home also stopped, gave the men Gatorades and filled buckets of water from the outdoor shower nozzle on the back of their trailer.

The fire was estimated to be about 100 feet long and 25 feet wide. The passersby worked until a BC Wildfire Service truck arrived and a firefighter put out the final hot spots. Evidence showed a cigarette butt to be the cause of the fire.
