ER rally scheduled after latest closures

A rally to protest the latest ER closures will be held Sunday Oct 1st at Central Park (near the RCMP detachment), from 1-1:45pm.

Organizers stress, however, that this rally is "not about mandates or vaccines so please create your sign accordingly". They say "Mayor Goetz and Council will be there and will address the crowd. This may be our last opportunity (due to winter) to make the government understand how we feel, it is your chance to say NO MORE CLOSURES!"

Organizers are hoping that "a couple thousand people" will turn out for the rally — to really send the message.

CFJC reported, yesterday: "Mayor Mike Goetz stated that he's been calling other Interior mayors in Oliver, Keremeos and New Denver, who are facing similar issues, and they plan to support the Merritt protest from their own communities this weekend."

Monday night's closure was the first this week, then Wednesday evening Interior Health announced the NV Hospital's Emergency Dept would be closed Thurs 8am-Fri 8am. 2 hours later they announced they'd have to close overnight Wed as well. 2 hours after that, they said they'd "secured nursing coverage", and would remain open until the 24-hour closure which would start Thursday morning.

Snow tire season starts this weekend

Merritt RCMP want to remind the public that as of October 1st, there is a requirement to have winter tires on your vehicle when driving on the Coquihalla Highway and Highway 97C.

Winter tires or chains are required on most routes in BC from October 1st to April 30th. For select highways not located through mountain passes and/or high snowfall areas, tire and chain requirements end March 31. These routes are marked with regulatory signs posted on highways throughout the province.

Failing to put the proper tires on your vehicles could result in \$121 fine & a tow.

Fall respiratory illness season

The Province and public-health officials announced measures yesterday, in the face of the upcoming respiratory illness season.

Invitations for immunization appointments for most people will begin on Oct. 10, and influenza & COVID-19 vaccines can be booked for the same time, if you wish, free for everyone. Invitations will roll out incrementally throughout the month of October.

To increase protections in health-care facilities in the province, medical mask wearing will be required by all health-care workers, volunteers, contractors and visitors in patient care areas starting October 3.
