I was approached by a friend some weeks ago regarding an illness. She, like one million other people in BC does not have a family doctor. I was a surgeon and family doctor for more than forty years and retired when Interior Health Authority took over local health 'care'.

It seemed that this lady had an inflammatory condition so I said she needed some blood tests and possibly an X-ray. She would have to go to the Emergency Room to get tested.

At the Merritt ER she saw a physician (from out of town) and received treatment. She also asked him to fill in a sickness form for her employer. He charged her \$160 cash for this, which went straight into his pocket!

He would probably make \$3000-\$4000 for working a 24hour emergency shift.

Wouldn't you think that would be enough without charging a sick person another \$160?

Emergency room doctors need only work four shifts a month to make an excellent living. Things have to change.

**Watering restrictions stepped back to Level 3**

Last Friday, the City of Merritt stepped back watering restrictions to Level 3 restrictions, from the more stringent Level 5 restrictions initiated in mid-August. The change is based on the Prov. of BC downgrading the drought level slightly from Level 5 to Level 4.

With the 'lighter' restrictions, residents can sprinkler 2 times a week — even numbered addresses Thursday & Sunday; and odd numbered addresses Tuesday & Saturday.

Hand watering of plants (excluding lawns), washing vehicles, or power washing with a user-controlled flow nozzle with shut-off valve is permitted at anytime during level 3 watering restrictions. The City recommends washing vehicles over grass or gravel when possible so that run off water drains into the earth instead of down the storm drains.

**Cat. 2 open burning prohibitions rescinded**

As a result of decreased temperatures, higher relative humidities, and good overnight recoveries, Category 2 Open Burning was permitted throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre, effective at 12 noon last Friday, October 6.

Also permitted now are fireworks; sky lanterns; binary exploding targets; air curtain burners; and burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description.

Category 3 open fires remain prohibited until noon on Oct. 13, or until the order is rescinded.

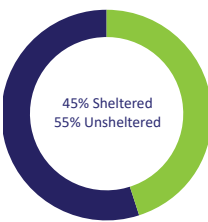
## Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count

People were identified as experiencing homelessness compared to 43 in 2020.

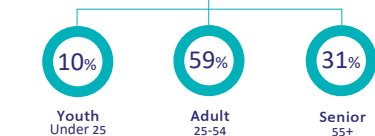
Where did individuals stay the night of the count?



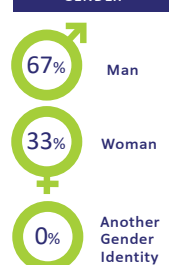
