## Home Routes concert series is back

The *Home Routes* concert series is coming back to Merritt! The concert series was launched in 2007 to build more infrastructure for Folk Musicians to play more concerts in more communities across Canada. The Nicola Valley Arts Council is sponsoring the venue, chairs, coffee/tea. Artists are hosted free in private homes on their cross-BC tour.

The first artist is Bobby Dove on Sat Oct 21 at the Arts Centre, 2051 Voght St, next to Kekuli Cafe, 7pm. Tickets are \$20 at the door. All proceeds in the series go to the artists.

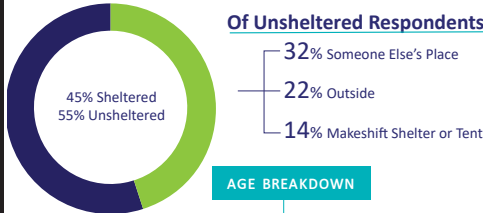
## Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count
