So that everyone understands About snow removal

With the current slow-moving arctic front clashing with a low pressure system from the coast — and the first significant snow of the season — thoughts turn to everyone's top-of-mind topic for winter: snow removal. The City has explained their snow removal procedure on their website... basically this:

The City operates its snow-clearing program around the specific climatic conditions for our valley, based on Environment Canada Historical Climate Normals (1981-2010). Those stats say that Merritt sees an average annual snow-fall of about 26 inches, with the average snow depth for November 1cm, December 5cm, January 5cm and February 2cm, and all other months 0cm. They say this means, effectively, that we don't see significant snow accumulation because it tends to melt... (Unless it doesn't!)

City's approach to snow removal

"As significant snow accumulation is rare, the City's snow removal efforts tend to be more geared towards management of ice, over the bulk of the winter season."

Snow is simply plowed to the side of the road (since snow removal is not necessary as it typically melts). In most areas, when temperatures get very cold, the snow is generally plowed, graded, and sanded. A brine or sand/salt mix is used in specified areas and is weather forecast-dependent. Snow removal is not specified/required except for the downtown area and only when there is no forecast of potential melting.

For snowfall between 2-8 inches, snow removal is required within 8 or 30 hours, depending on the priority zone. For snowfall under 2 inches, no timeframe is defined. For 'aberrant snow accumulations', ie. greater than 8 inches, no timeframe is indicated and the priority shifts towards "making streets passable".

Resident obligations

"Every owner or occupier of residential-zoned property shall remove snow or ice from sidewalks or pathways abutting the said property within 24 hours of accumulation." And "every owner or occupier of commercial- or industrial-zoned property shall remove snow or ice from sidewalk or pathways abutting the said property by 10am and additionally as needed."

Snow clearing program for seniors

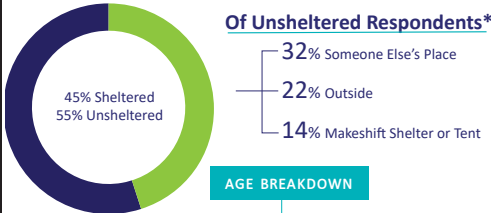
