Every winter since 2001 the Hospital parking lot has become a skating rink, making life difficult for old people before they even get into the Hospital and wait for hours to see a doctor.

I am pleading with the City Council and the TNRD (and most of all, the Indigenous Bands) to tell Interior Health to deal with snow removal.

Utility corridor functional planning study

The City of Merritt will hold an open house on Monday, November 6, 6-8pm at the Civic Centre.

The City is completing a Functional Planning Study of the utility corridors in East Merritt. These areas have a fully serviced sanitary sewer system — though much of the current system is near the end of its service life. And with growth and other contributors, much of the system is over capacity or performing at a low service level.

The City's Sanitary Sewer Masterplan from 2012 is also due for an update. This Functional Planning Study will provide the basis for guiding future upgrades, the sanitary sewer system and also in all infrastructure service areas.

The City has engaged a consultant to determine the most efficient alignment(s) for sewer upgrades. The study will help guide the City's capital upgrade plans for the design, development, repair, and replacement of underground utility work in the entire study area.

During the open house, residents can expect to see detailed information displays and be able to speak directly with City representatives about the proposed project.

Teck Highland Valley Copper is proposing to expand its open-pit copper mine near Logan Lake, which would extend operations to 2040 or lon ger.

They will hold an in-person open house on Wed, Nov 8, 4-8pm at Comfort Inn and Suites, 3713 De Wolf Way. A second open house will be in Logan Lake on Nov 9, 10am-2pm at the Fire Hall.

The Environmental Assessment Office is holding a public comment period on Teck's application for an environmental assessment certificate, which details the project's design, operations, potential effects and proposed mitigation measures.

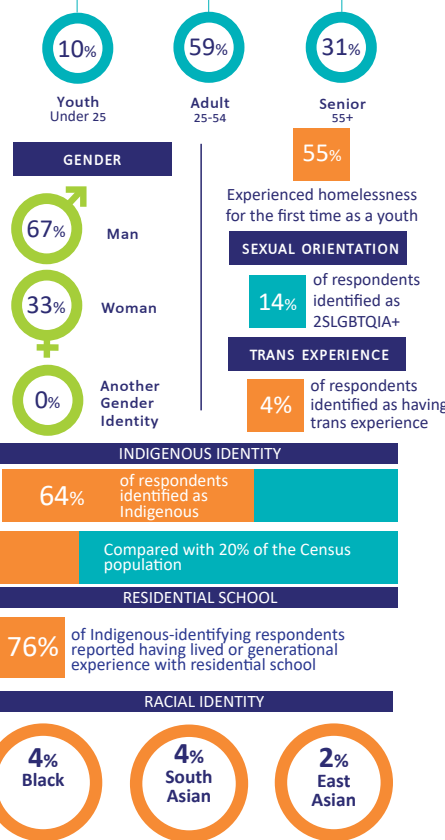
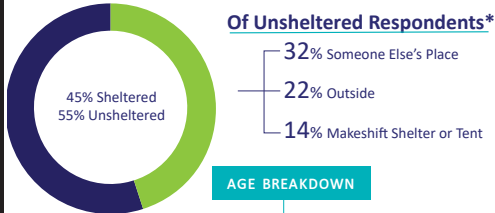
Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count
