Merritt lowest temp record broken

According to Environment and Climate Change Canada, a 104-year old lowest temperature record was broken (for the day) on Thursday, October 26th — it was registered at -8.6°C. The record that was broken was -8.3°C set in 1919, in the second year of record-keeping.

While the record low is just for that day... The temps this weekend continued to plummet: -8.7°C on Friday and -11.8°C on Saturday (also records for the period of 2011-2023). The record high for Oct. 26 in Merritt is 16.7°C in 2018 (for the period of 2011-2023).

Tourism infrastructure project funding

The Province's Destination Development Fund supports tourism businesses by developing and rejuvenating tourism infrastructure. 31 new recipients will receive nearly \$15 million in 2023-24 with one-time grants.

Among them, Merritt & Nicola Valley Destination Marketing Society will receive \$500,000 to replace bridges, signage and a groomer for snowmobile and XC skiing trails.

The District of Logan Lake will receive \$992,285 for the expansion of the existing Logan Lake Municipal Campground which will include new campsites, off-season cabins/roundhouses and washroom facilities.

Projects were chosen for their contribution to communities, benefits to the tourism economy, and support for sustainability and accessibility.

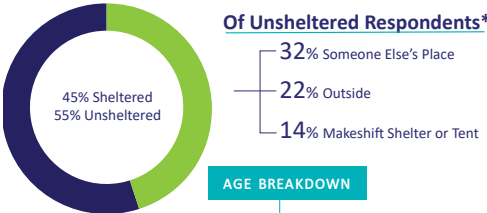
Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count

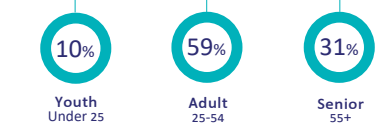

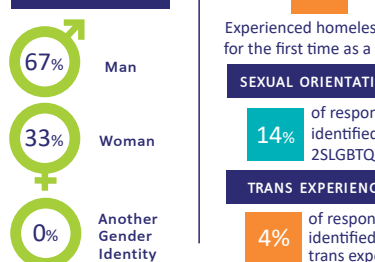
Where did individuals stay the night of the count?
