## Halloween stabbing

On October 31, Merritt RCMP were called to the NV Hospital, after witnesses observed a stabbing take place at the adjacent Merritt community garden.

The suspect fled from the area on foot and the victim, a 42-year old Merritt man, walked into the emergency room with a stab wound to his torso. The victim was in stable condition and ultimately transported to Royal Inland Hospital to be treated for his injuries.

The suspect was located by Police Dog Services, still in the area, and was safely taken into custody without incident.

On November 1, Braden Douglas Jackson was charged with one count of Aggravated Assault, Section 268 (2) CC and held in custody. Mr. Jackson's next court appearance is set for a virtual bail hearing on November 7, 2023.

## \$2 million more from Prov. for dike repairs

Nearly 2 years on and no federal money forthcoming (which they promised 2 days after the 2021 flood), the Province of BC is stepping up again to help repair parts of the diking along the Coldwater River between Voght St & Garcia St — Claybanks RV park.

Merritt will receive \$2 million to build the 200-metre long section of dike.

The Province will also provide \$150,000 for a flood-risk assessment and emergency preparedness project to support the city's actions before and during future flood events. City public works staff will use the plan during flood events to prioritize inspections, erect flood protection in high-risk areas and implement emergency response measures.

Thanks to \$2 million in funding from the BC Ministry of Emergency Management & Climate Readiness, announced February 2023, construction on the Public Works dike is scheduled for summer of 2024, pending permit approvals.

The Flood Mitigation Plan adopted by council in November 2022 will take an estimated \$109 million to construct — to date, the City has received a fraction of the necessary funding.

The City and the Province continue to lobby the Federal government for support. At this time, Infrastructure Canada is "unable to provide an estimate of the timing for a decision."

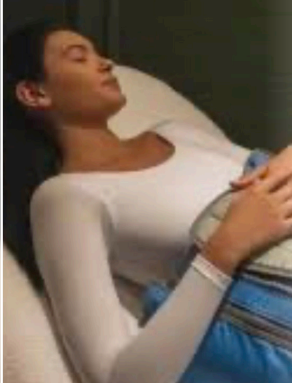

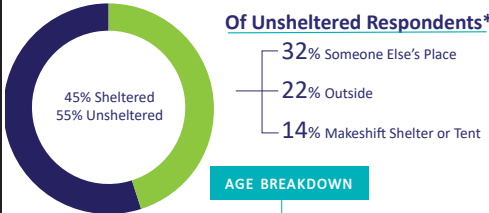
## Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count

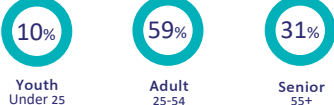

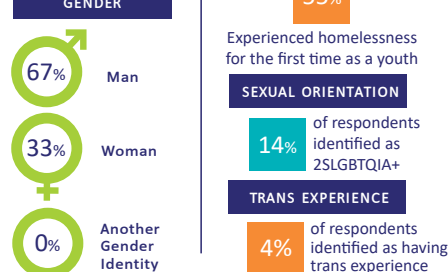
Where did individuals stay the night of the count?
