Interior Health-wide drug advisory

Interior Health is advising residents that a fake tablet that looks like an 8mg Dilaudid tablet, Hydromorphone tablet — being sold as Dilaudid / Hydromorphone / Dillies — contains isotonicitazene (5%) and poses a very high risk of overdose.

Isotonicitazene is equally or more potent than fentanyl. This means that these fake tablets may be 20+ times stronger than real Dilaudid / hydromorphone tablets.

The only way to be sure a tablet is genuine is if you get it directly from a pharmacist. Drug checking can help you find out the composition of your substance. The advisory is in effect until Nov 21.

BC Emergency Alerts test on radio, TV & cellphones

A Canada-wide test of the National Public Alerting System will occur at 1:55 pm today, Wednesday, Nov. 15, to improve public safety in the event of an emergency.

The test alert will go to all compatible cellphones and interrupt radio and television broadcasts. The test message to cellphones will read: "This is a TEST of the BC Emergency Alert system. This is ONLY a TEST. In an emergency, this message would tell you what to do to stay safe. This information could save your life. Click for more info: www.emergencyinfbc.ca/test. This is ONLY a TEST. No action is required."

The test will assess the system's readiness for an actual emergency and identify any required adjustments.

The National Public Alerting System is a collaborative initiative between federal, provincial and territorial governments, as well as industry partners. It provides a standard alerting capability to rapidly warn the public of imminent or unfolding hazards and threats to life and safety.

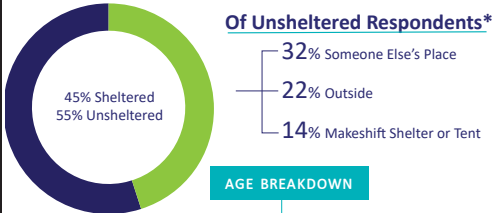
Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count
