River ceremony & new bridge details

The drumming seemed to draw the bald eagle that circled above the site on the Coldwater River where the rebuilt Middlesboro bridge is to be — a good omen for the river ceremony yesterday morning.

With the second anniversary of the flood just the day before, Mayor Goetz says that even though the bulk of the required diking is not yet funded, there has been quite a lot of progress. "Last year this time, 80% of the homes were empty. And the school was closed. We are way further along than other communities," he said.

The prime contractor for the new bridge was announced earlier this month, Emil Anderson Construction, with conceptual design drawings by Urban Systems. The new Middlesboro bridge will be a single steel span across the 70m between banks, that is with no centre pier which requires more difficult work in the river bed, but comes at a higher cost. The span will allow 3 times more space under the bridge as the old one and no obstruction to debris. The lanes on the bridge will be built to current standards (wider than previously) and there will be a multi-use path across it as well.

Detailed construction engineering is in progress, and the build should start in summer 2024 (once the freshet is over) and be drivable by November. Final landscaping would happen in spring 2025.

An elder from Coldwater Band who spoke during the ceremony said: "My mother told me: you cannot stop water. I've lived by this river for more than 70 years and I have seen what it can do." He said he's seen it take land, and homes, and people. And he's seen it "red with sockey, and black with coho", though not in recent years. But it also nourishes & cleanses. "Respect the water. Be gentle with it."

Permanent repairs to Coq now complete

Permanent repairs to the Coquihalla are complete after it washed out during unprecedented flooding 2 years ago.

The repaired highway features six new climate-resilient bridges built in place of the ones that were lost in November 2021. The six bridge spans located at three different locations have been rebuilt to handle extreme weather. The new permanent bridges are now finished at Bottletop Bridge, 50 km south of town, and Jessica Bridge, 20 km north of Hope. The bridges at Juliet, 53 km south of Merritt, were completed earlier this year.

"Thank you to the Nlaka'pamux communities, Silyx Nation, Peters First Nation and Yale First Nation along with their monitors, for their support through the washout and rebuild process; and to the many contractors, unions, ministry and road-maintenance staff who worked to rebuild this piece of highway that is so important to the movement of goods in our province," said Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure Rob Fleming.

The new bridges are built to withstand high water levels by using deep-pile footings & longer spans. Large rock protection has been added to protect the bridges from erosion & scour. Trees, shrubs & grasses have been planted to encourage stream-side re-vegetation and support overall restoration of aquatic and land habitat.

More than 300 workers used 200 pieces of equipment and moved more than 400,000 cubic metres of gravel, rock and other material to repair and reopen Highway 5 to commercial vehicle traffic in 35 days, on Dec. 20, 2021, and to all traffic on Jan. 19, 2022.

KEA5, a joint venture between Kiewit Infrastructure British Columbia and Emil Anderson Construction, completed the bridges two months ahead of schedule.

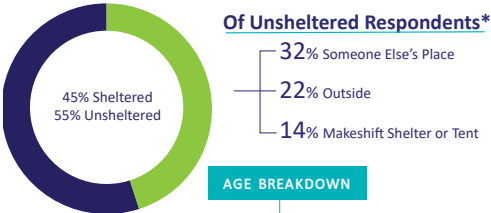
Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count

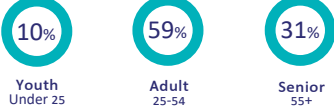

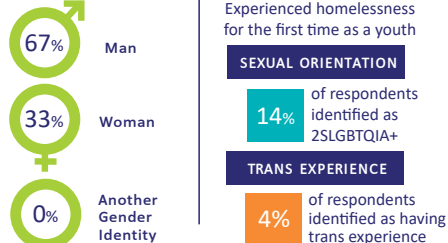
Where did individuals stay the night of the count?



AGE BREAKDOWN



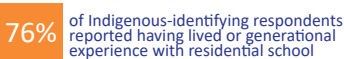
