RCMP seeking info about a goat killed by a pitbull

The Merritt RCMP is seeking the public's assistance to identify where a goat came from.

On November 24, the Merritt RCMP was alerted to an online post, where a suspect posted a video of a pitbull violently attacking a white goat inside a house, where onlookers stood by encouraging the attack.

Officers were able to identify the house as being in the 2600 block of Granite Ave., and obtained a search warrant under the Criminal Code of Canada and the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act. The South East District Emergency Response Team were called and assisted by executing the search warrant. The SPCA aided during the search.

"Sadly, we found the remains of a goat during our search," said Staff Sergeant Josh Roda. "We are trying to identify where the goat came from. We would like to determine if the goat was stolen, sold or given away."

The goat had a white body, brown on the top of its head and was wearing a collar in the video.

Anyone with information about the goat is asked to call the Merritt RCMP at 250-378-4262.

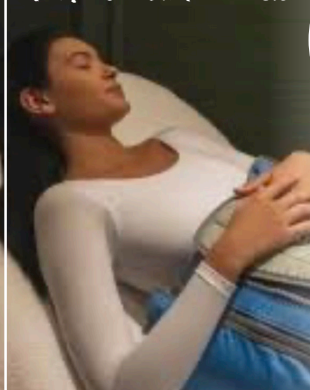

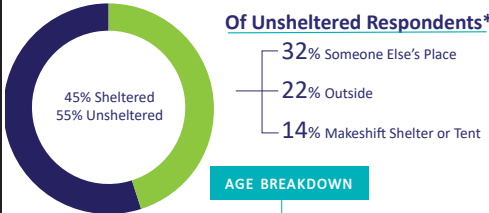
Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count
