Two local projects part of TNRD 2024-2028 Capital Plan

Smith Pioneer Park improvements (\$290,000) and Lower Nicola Eco-Depot building rebuild & new recycling baler (\$960,000) are 2 local projects, out of the total 9 significant projects across the regional district, that were approved by the TNRD Board in their capital plan (which outlines capital projects included in the 2024 budget, and budget projections for the upcoming 5 years).

The 2 local projects are both scheduled for completion this year.

This year's Capital Plan includes spending of \$11,735,901, down \$1.1 million from last year.

TMX update

The majority of pipeline construction on the Trans Mountain Expansion Project is complete between Merritt and Coquihalla Summit. During this final phase of work, small crews are working intermittently to complete valve installation; right-of-way and access road cleanup; and reseeding, replanting and land reclamation.

The Merritt Camp Community is now closed. Winterization and demobilization work is proceeding.

Kamloops-Merritt Pipeline Construction

Work will commence in a series of phased activities along the pipeline right-of-way between Kamloops and Merritt, including surveying, flagging and staking the right-of-way, mobilization of crews and equipment, preparing the right-of-way, clearing and grading, delivery and staging of pipe, trenching, welding, lowering of pipe, backfilling and restoration of the right-of-way. Property assessments in the mail

Property owners should be receiving their 2024 assessment notices this week, which reflect market value as of Jul 1, 2023.

BC Assessment says that with the softer real estate market, most changes in home values will be somewhere between -10% to +5% in Thompson-Okanagan communities.

Specifically in Merritt, a "typical" house valued at \$475,000 last year, will be about \$438,000 this year, for a decrease of 8%.

Only a few communities are showing an increase of value: Lillooet +3%, Sicamous +4%, Spallumcheen +5%, Coldstream +4%, Vernon +2%, and Armstrong +1%. Lytton is the exception with larger increases (+26%) as market activity recovers in the community.

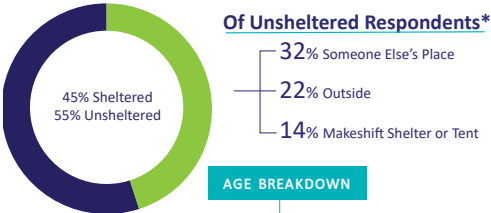
Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count

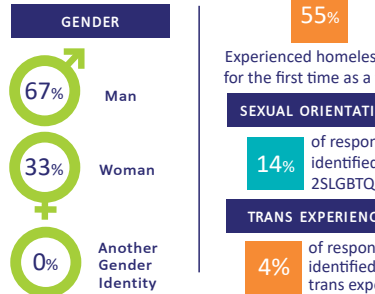
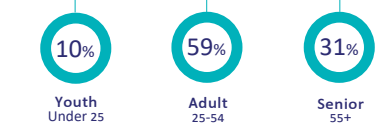
