Fatal collision on

the Coq, Monday
Merritt RCMP are asking anyone who witnessed the collision on January 8 on the Coquihalla Hwy approx. 45km south of town, or who has dash camera footage and has not yet spoken to police, to con-

On Monday, police were alerted to a collision near Larson Hill. A Ford F150 travelling southbound, crossed the center median ditch and went into on coming traffic. The vehicle struck a semi truck and trailer heading northbound in the slow lane. The incident occured prior to the start of the snow.

The driver of the F150 was declared deceased at the scene and the passenger was airlifted to hospital. The driver of the semi truck sustained minor injuries.

The driver has been identified as a New Westminster father who had been driving his son home from a U15A1 hockey tournament in Kelowna, when the crash occurred.

A post on the Coquihalla Road Reports (And Area) fb page said: "My 57 year old father and 14 year old brother were in the crash on Larson Hill. My father took the impact on the driver's side to save my brother's life and did not survive. My brother was airlifted to hospital but

The incident caused a highway closure and long delays for travellers.

"We are still investigating the exact cause of the collision. Our hearts go out to the family of the deceased", says S/ Sgt. Josh Roda. "We want to remind the public to slow down and drive to the conditions this winter. The conditions on the Coquihalla Highway can change quickly." New Extreme Weather Response Shelter

Last week, BC Housing, in association with the ASK Wellness Society and the Nicola Valley Shelter and Support Society, distributed a letter to neighbours about the new Extreme Weather Response Shelter located at 1755 Coldwater Ave, the Cadet Hall.


It will operate between January 7 & March 31, 2024, from 6pm-10am when an EWR alert is issued for Merritt, when temperatures (sustained or feels like) at or below -7°C and/or snowstorm accumulating more than 5cm (these conditions are subject to change on direction from the Medical Health Officer).

ASK Wellness Society (ASK) and the Nicola Valley Shelter and Support Society (NVSSS) will partner together to operate the shelter and provide guests with individual sleeping mats, a warm meal, transportation to and from the shelter, with multiple staff on-site.

According to the 2023 Point-in-Time Homeless Count, 67 people are experiencing homelessness in Merritt, compared to 43 in 2020. Winter weather can create a life-or-death situation for people, making it vital to have sufficient shelter spaces for people to get warm and access basic services. Old Merritt cookbook available online

The Merritt cookbook is from a collection of similar community cookbooks from Wellington, Riondel, Fanny Bay, Port Alberni, BC and Regina, SK, owned by the University of the Fraser Valley.
