Man hurling rocks and insults

The Merritt RCMP are looking for information in relation to a man who was hurling rocks and insults at a local business and its patrons.

On the morning of January 4th, the Merritt RCMP received reports of a young man hurling rocks at a business located on the 2300 block of Nicola Ave. The suspect was also hurling insults at anyone who came into contact with the him.

Merritt Front Line Officers responded and spoke with witnesses, which allowed them to quickly identify the man, who was well known to police. The man was located a short time later and tried to resist arrest by climbing in the window of his residence once he saw police approaching. He was arrested after a brief struggle with officers.

The man was held in custody until he was sober. He was released on an undertaking with an upcoming court date, along with a number of release conditions. The Merritt RCMP will be recommending several charges to the BC Prosecution Service.

Gateway 286 will provide employment and revenue to our 5 communities and in addition this development will provide a vital transportation hub for all the east and west bound traffic on Highway 5A.

We wish to thank both the Provincial and Federal Governments for supporting us in this endeavour. In addition, we wish to thank the Mayor, Council and staff of the City of Merritt who have worked tirelessly to enable the project to proceed. We look forward to working with Troika Management Corp. in building this important future for the region of Thompson Okanagan," said Lower Nicola Indian Band Chief Stuart Jackson.

The multi-faceted development agreement includes a portion of the property for the 1st phase of development: new 30,000 sq ft highway commercial centre including restaurants, convenience retail, gas bar, dog park and western Canada's largest electric vehicle charging station. Phase 1 encompasses 7 acres of the total 28.6-acre parcel.

Design & style will recognize Nicola Valley First Nations culture and history, and the partners have committed to provide employment, training and economic opportunities for members of area First Nations.

A Development Permit Application will be submitted in early Spring 2024 and construction is expected to begin next summer.


Merritt - 2023 Homeless Count


