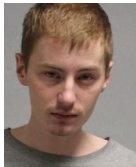
## Williams Lk RCMP seeking man with ties to Merritt

## New year, new licenses & permits

### Business licenses

Every organization that conducts business within the boundaries of the City of Merritt, including home-based operations and transient operators like couriers, are required to maintain a current business licence. They are valid, from the first day of the calendar year to the last day of the year, and must be renewed every year.

If you renew your business licence before the due date (which will be February 7, this year), you will receive a 10% discount off the \$150 business licence fee for a total of \$135.

For renewals after the April 10 deadline, a 20% fine will be added, for a total of \$180. New business licenses applied for throughout the year will be pro-rated.

### Dog licenses

After a stint with an off-site dog licensing service, the City is again managing them in-house. All pet owners will need to visit City Hall in person to set up a new account. Bring a valid veterinarian certificate to prove that the animal has been spayed or neutered in order to get the discount. This one-time, in person, account set-up will not be required in future years.

Residents may have up to 2 dogs per residence (a residence includes any secondary suite). Bylaw Services may, upon request, allow an owner to have more than 2 dogs in exceptional circumstances. Every resident dog requires a valid licence. Dog licence tags must be affixed to their collar and visible at all times.

### Fire permits

Fire Permits expired on December 31, cost is to renew is \$25.

Residents wishing to have a campfire or other small confined fire on their property (not exceeding 0.5 metres in height and at least 4 meters from any structure or property line) require a permit from the City of Merritt. Category 2 and 3 open fires are not allowed at any time. Fireworks are only permitted between October 16 and November 1.
