Canadian Red Cross Residential Mitigation Incentive Program

Residents who registered with the Canadian Red Cross due to the 2021 BC Floods and Extreme Weather event are receiving emails this week about a new Red Cross program.

The Residential Mitigation Incentive Program is offered to support residents impacted by the 2021 BC Floods and Extreme Weather event by providing financial incentives to eligible residents who are interested in undertaking mitigative actions to make their homes more resilient to future flood events.

The program covers specific maintenance activities (up to \$750) & mitigation activities (up to an additional \$4,250) towards select activities. There are eligibility criteria, including having "a primary residence that was not damaged or incurred minor damage due to the 2021 British Columbia Floods and Extreme Weather event". Activities completed before January 16, 2024, are not eligible for reimbursement.
