## Walk to mark 1-year anniversary of Miguel Mack's homicide

With the 1-year anniversary of Miguel's disappearance on Tuesday, the Mack family will hold a walk in his honour today, March 1, starting at 5pm from at 2337 Coutlee Ave., winding through Merritt and ending at Spirit Square. Please bring a candle and join for a moment of silence.

The RCMP's Southeast District Major Crime Unit is renewing a call for information.

"To date, our investigation has shown that Miguel Mack's disappearance was the result of foul play and that Miguel Mack is the victim of a homicide," RCMP Staff Sgt. Jason Smart said, noting the investigation remains a priority for the Southeast District Major Crimes Unit.

"It is important to police that the person(s) responsible for his disappearance and murder be held accountable and it is even more important for Mr. Mack's family to be provided with some semblance of closure so that they can begin to heal from this terrible ordeal."

Police are urging people who may have information about the disappearance of Miguel Mack to contact the Southeast District Major Crime Unit at 1-877-987-8477.

"There are people out there with knowledge of Miguel Mack's disappearance and we are asking those individuals to come forward and contact the police," Smart added.

Summer and winter temperatures are never excessively hot or cold. Notwithstanding its elevation Merritt is sheltered by the surrounding mountains from the cold north winds in the winter time and in the summertime the same mountains insure cool evenings and nights. The valley is famous for its sunshine and has been well named "the valley of sunshine" for there is scarcely a day in the year when that luminary fails to make an appearance.
