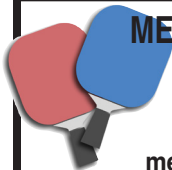

More prescribed burns

The BC Wildfire Service in partnership with the Coldwater Indian Band and Coldwater Fire Department will be conducting a prescribed burn approx. 7.5 kms southwest of Merritt - Coldwater IR #1. It will be up to 110 hectares in size starting this week until mid-April 2024. Smoke may be visible from town and to travelers along Hwy 5 (south of Merritt).

In partnership with the Lower Nicola Indian Band and Lower Nicola Fire Department, BCWS will be conducting a prescribed burn project approx. 6 kms northwest of Merritt. This prescribed burn will be up 210 hectares in size, starting this week and continue until mid-April, or until grass is too green to burn. Smoke may be visible to the City of Merritt, Lower Nicola residents and travelers along Highway 8 and Highway 97D.

Work for these projects will be dependent on local weather and venting conditions and will only occur if conditions are favorable. Local weather and venting conditions will impact how much of the project is completed this spring.

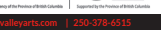
