**Merritt's Edison Motors pulls up stakes to build manufacturing plant in Terrace**

Edison Motors' new hybrid electric heavy duty truck is now officially road-worthy. Their L500 semi prototype — named the "Topsy" — has been granted a vehicle identification number and registration. And the company now has four orders for the truck, which uses regenerative braking for much of its power.

They will soon be leaving the Nicola Valley, laying off staff here; and opening a new manufacturing plant in Terrace to build the trucks, and hiring 30 employees there.

Co-founder Chace Barber said in a social media post: "We tried for 2 years to find industrial land available here. The City has no land for sale; the land that is available was all bought up by (largely) foreign owners, real estate investment companies, who refuse to sell. The TNRD refuses to rezone any land not inside the City. Now I have to lay off our workers, move away from my family in order to grow Edison Motors. We tried everything we could and there was just no way we could make it work."

**Local ballet talent excels at Kamloops Performing Arts Festival**

Ten-year old Kate Van Rensburg is no stranger to high-level dance competition. And she excelled recently when she participated in the dance portion the Kamloops Festival of the Performing Arts, March 10-15, 2024.

Kate competed in several sections, and was awarded: Ballet 1st place with a score of 88.5%; Ballet Contemporary 1st place with 87.5%; Contemporary 1st place with 91.5%; Jazz 2nd place with 90.5%; and Tap 3rd place with 89%. Her report cards especially highlighted her "impressive and mature" technical abilities.

Kate also attended technique classes during KFPA hosted by the judges for Ballet, Jazz and Tap. She was awarded the KFPA Junior Ballet Scholarship and also received the Junior Ballet Competitor recommendation by the Adjudicator to compete at the Performing Arts BC Provincial Festival to be held in Fort St. John, this coming June 2-6.

Kate is currently training at The Dance Gallery in Kamloops.

**5-year financial plan open house**

After several public Committee of the Whole meetings on a draft budget in December, and public meetings on related financials, the City is ready to submit its final recommended 2024-2028 Financial Plan, to be presented and adopted during the Tuesday, April 9 council meeting.

They are now accepting comments from the public until Monday, April 8, 8pm. City staff and council will be available at an Open House on Monday, April 8, from 6pm-8pm at the Civic Centre to provide details on the current financial plan and hear comments from the public.

The 'bottom line': to balance the budget for 2024-2025, and not continue to operate in a deficit, the City needs to set its revenue target at a 12.5% increase over 2023 levels. The new tax rate for 2024 must be set by mid-May.
