Addictions care beds for Merritt

As part of an additional 66 treatment beds in the Interior funded & administered by the Canadian Mental Health Association - BC Division (CMHA-BC), 5 beds will be coming to Merritt this year. They will be operated by ASK Wellness Society, and will open soon, once final implementation steps are completed.

To access these free treatment and recovery services, people can refer themselves or be referred by their health-care professional or other organizations. Services include a live-in environment, counselling, medication management and a strong emphasis on community & connection throughout recovery.

These new beds will bring the total number in the Interior Health region to 391.

Mental health & addiction supports for youth

Children, youth and families in Merritt & Princeton will benefit from seamless mental-health and addiction services as BC expands Integrated Child and Youth (ICY) teams to School District 58 Nicola-Similkameen.

The team in Nicola-Similkameen School District will connect children and their caregivers to services such as, peer and cultural supports, and counselling. Services will be offered by clinical counsellors connected to schools, youth substance-use and mental-health clinicians, Elders or workers supporting Indigenous children and youth, as well as family and youth peer supports. Together, they will meet the youth where they feel most comfortable, whether in schools or other community settings.

Approx. 75% of serious mental-health issues emerge before the age of 25.

The team supporting Princeton and Merritt will join 12 other ICY team communities in the province. 7 additional communities will soon be announced.

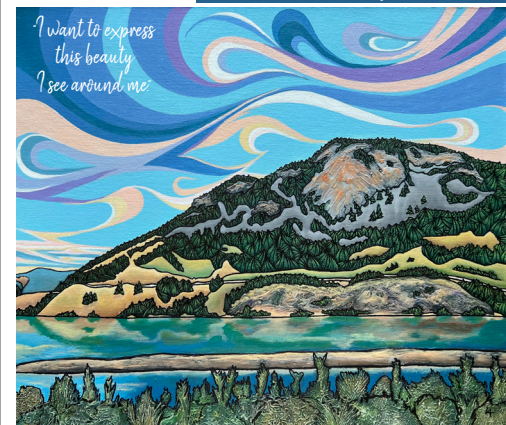
