## sk'únk'w'itkax'ni, discovery of a new species of moth

The previously-unknown sk'únk-w'itkax'ni (shkwoon-kwleet-kaxh-nee / brown copper moth) was discovered during joint research for the Highland Valley Copper Biodiversity Monitoring Program, by K'en T'em Limited Partnership's environmental monitoring crew.

The new species of moth is in the *tridentiforma* genus, and is represented by 64 individuals, most found at the program's reference sites, spread across several locations at Teck Highland Valley Copper Operations, the Logan Lake burn area, and 3 off-site reference sites.

Traditionally, the person who first describes a newfound animal is entitled to name it. According to Cit'xw Nlaka'pamux Assembly (CNA), the naming of this species is a powerful act of cultural preservation and revitalization that acknowledges the importance of Indigenous Knowledge in biodiversity conservation.

The new moth was given its species name in nle'kepmxcín after consultation with nle'kepmxcín Elders, Knowledge Keepers, and several CNA and K'en T'em departments.

Amelia Washington shares the phrase "q'wəc'w'ecúyn'x tk nkikax'ni," which loosely means warm area/ warm climate moth, providing insight into the moth's origin.

"We extend many thanks to our language keepers who have guided us in creating a new word in nle'kepmxcín, for identifying this recently discovered new species of moth: Maurice Michell, Amelia Washington, Bev Phillips, Marty Aspinall and Bernice Garcia", says Madelynn Albert, nle'kepmxcín Manager of the CNA.

HVC's Biodiversity Monitoring Program research assesses additional biodiversity monitoring techniques to compare reclamation progress to naturally disturbed (i.e., forest fire) and undisturbed reference sites. Various monitoring information items and samples such as game cameras, soil samples, bio-acoustic monitoring and malaise trap samples were taken across 27 locations. Field sampling was conducted between July and September of 2023.

## Dale Revell missing

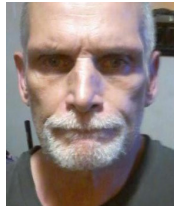
Merritt RCMP is requesting the public's assistance in locating a missing Merritt resident.
