Emergency alert on cell phones, tv & radio

As part of Emergency Preparedness Week next week, an emergency alert test will be issued to cellphones, television and radio at 10:55am on Wed, May 8.

The test alert will go to all compatible cellphones, and will interrupt radio and tv broadcasts. It is to assess the system's readiness for an actual emergency and identify any required adjustments.

In 2022, the Province expanded the use of BC Emergency Alerts beyond tsunami warnings to include imminent threats from floods, wildfires and extreme heat emergencies. In addition, the police issue alerts for civil emergencies and Amber Alerts, and the federal government issues emergency alerts for events and hazards related to federal responsibilities, including tornados, thunderstorms, storm surge and hurricanes. During the 2023 wildfire season, the Province issued 24 BC Emergency Alerts providing timely, potentially life-saving info.

Cikilaxwm, cultural burning

Cultural and prescribed fire is a land stewardship practice that can help reduce the intensity of naturally occurring wildfires, while returning an integral and culturally significant process to the land base.

According to BC Wildfire Service, there were a total of 58 cultural burn projects — also referred to as prescribed or controlled burns — throughout the province in 2022 & 2023, with more than 3,800 hectares treated. Of those 58 projects, 38 of them were developed or co-developed with Indigenous communities. This year, there are 61 burn projects in the works, according to the province.

Cikilaxwm was a regular practice conducted by syilx Okanagan Nation and others for thousands of years. These low-intensity, controlled burns were done to mitigate the threat of wildfires and maintain forest health for all beings.

But with colonialism came the removal of fire from the ecosystem. Treating and maintaining forest health took a back seat to extracting and logging, and settlers favoured reactionary wildfire strategies that have resulted in the accumulation of debris in forests, leading to more devastating wildfires experienced in the present day.

This history of aggressive and highly effective wildfire suppression in the province has resulted in significant build-up of forest fuels, greater tree encroachment on grasslands, and 'in-filling' of once open, dry forests. This has increased the risk of devastating wildfires & negatively impacted biodiversity and forest health.

The Province's use of the term "cultural and prescribed fire" is intended to acknowledge Indigenous cultural burning as distinct from prescribed burning, while also acknowledging the intersection of Indigenous and Western fire management as both are practiced today.
