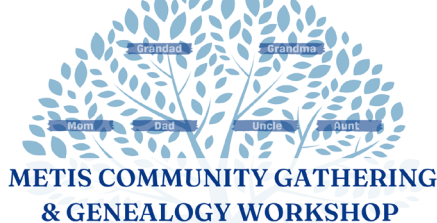

TNRD fire protection agreement with City

During their last meeting, TNRD Board Members voted to enter into a contract with the City of Merritt for the provision of fire protection services to a specific area in Lower Nicola, for a value of \$1,547,833 over a 5-year term.

The most recent contract with the City expired at the end of 2023, and negotiations began for a new, longer-term contract last year. An agreement was reached in principle at the end of the year, and fire protection services have continued uninterrupted. The level of service provided will be "exterior level protection", comparable to the service in all other TNRD fire protection areas.

Previous contracts with Merritt had been for terms less than 5 years. The most recent two contracts were 1-year terms, while they worked through service boundary changes in the Lower Nicola area, related to the end of a fire protection services previously provided through an agreement with the Lower Nicola Indian Band.

TNRD says that this new 5-year agreement will give tax stability moving forward.

Kate brings home more dance awards

Competing in the Junior Elite Solo Division, she brought home: 1 Silver, 3 Gold, 1 Sapphire, and got 3rd Overall in the Junior Elite Solo Division, Judges Choice award (Contemporary Ballet), and a scholarship to Sol Dance Collective.

Competing in the Intermediate Competitive Group Division with fellow *The Dance Gallery* dancers, they got 1 Silver, 4 Gold, were 4th Overall in the Intermediate Competitive/Elite Large Group division (Lyrical), and 5th Overall in the Intermediate Competitive/Elite Large Group division (Jazz).

Contaminated recycling still a problem

RecycleBC determines what materials can & cannot go in our curbside recycling bins. And they fine the City when the loads are contaminated with materials that are not allowed in the program.

The City says that nearly 90% of recycling bin contamination is flexible plastics, followed by glass, styrofoam and compost.

These materials are, however, recyclable at the Lower Nicola Eco Depot, as long as they are clean & separated.

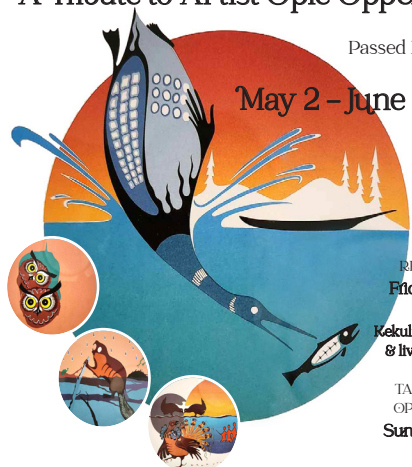
