Mountain bike trail network impacted by TransMountain

TransMountain advises that Coutlee Plateau trail users may notice impacts such as traffic, equipment, work crews, fencing, and temporary trail closures. To support the safety of recreation users and the completion of the work, a temporary trail closure of JP Cool, where it interacts with Trans Mountain's right-of-way, is required during the duration of the work. This temporary closure will be in effect while workers are on site and reopen after work hours. Crews typically work Monday through Saturday, 6am-6pm.

City staff by the numbers

Long gone are the days of a small town municipal staff, like for example: after Merritt came out of receivership in the early 1950s.

The CAO's 2024 Human Resource Report at the last council meeting outlines:

153 Employees as of May 24 2024: 40 Full Time Union; 2 Part Time Union; 28 Casual Union; 7 Term (rec assistants & instructors, ESS 2) average 3 to 4 hours per week, IT Coop; 31 exempt — ie. manager positions — (2 PT, 24 FT, 7 Mayor & Council); 35 on-call fire fighters.

FTE New Positions Created within the City of Merritt in 2024: 7 FT, 1 Seasonal, 1- two year term.

6 casual employees switched to full and part time positions. 14 union internal positions changed since January. 7 exempt internal position changed since January. 23 new hires since January. 8 employees left and 1 on Mat leave. Current open positions: Civil Engineering Technologist, Accounting I, Asset/Records Management, and Operations Manager.

Reminder: No drones in vicinity of wildfires

The BC Wildfire Service would like to remind residents that Transport Canada and the BC Wildfire Service explicitly prohibit the use of publicly operated unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) or drones of any size near a wildfire.

The area surrounding an active wildfire has an automatic airspace restriction of 5 nautical miles around the fire and up to 3,000 feet above ground level, and may be increased based on operational needs. The use of any aircraft, UAVs, or drones not associated with fire suppression activities is illegal. The presence of a UAV or drone near a wildfire can slow or shut down all aviation resources on the fire, and possibly ground crew operations due to safety concerns.

Flying a UAV in restricted airspace near a wildfire poses a significant safety risk to personnel, especially when low-flying firefighting aircraft are present. If a drone collides with firefighting aircraft, the consequences could be deadly.

This has been a reoccurring problem over the past few fire seasons and has impacted the BC Wildfire Service's fire-fighting response. There is zero tolerance for people who fly drones in active wildfire areas. Anyone found interfering with wildfire control efforts (including flying drones or UAVs) can face penalties up to \$100,000 and/or up to one year in jail.
