Cease all non-essential water use

At 9:15am yesterday, the City issued a Voyent Alert to cease all non-essential water usage until further notice.

The Voght Park well had a significant failure that affected the City's water distribution system.

By 5:30pm, the gasket in the Voght pump station well was replaced and undergoing high-pressure testing. Water has been tested and is potable. Unfortunately, water sprayed onto the electrical system during the failure. The electrical engineer is recommending that the system dry out for 48 hours before restarting and testing systems.

Meanwhile they have increased output on the Collettville Pump Station to compensate, reducing the severity of the impact of the Voght well failure.

However, the City is still not operating at full capacity. They continue to ask residents to limit non-essential water usage during this time and avoid watering lawns or doing outdoor washing. Watering of vegetable gardens will be permitted. They urge us to work together to conserve water to maintain fire protection capacity.

'Extreme' fire danger rating

The BC Wildfire Service's rating for Merritt has wavered between 'high' & 'extreme', but with the heat this week the forecast is for continued 'extreme' danger rating. At 'High' BCWS urges you to prep your emergency kit and ensure you have a working plan that the whole family understands. At 'Extreme' they say pay attention to the City of Merritt Voyent Alert!, local news, BC Wildfire Service, and other applicable forms of communication regarding the ongoing fire situations in our area.

Campfire ban starts Friday

Effective at 12 noon on Friday, July 12, Category 1 campfires will be prohibited throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre to help prevent human-caused wildfires. This campfire prohibition will remain in effect until noon on Oct. 11, unless otherwise rescinded.

This ban is in addition to the current Categories 2 & 3 open fires which also include fireworks; sky lanterns; binary exploding targets; air curtain burners; burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description; chimineas; and, tiki and similar kind of torches.

Anyone found in contravention of an open burning prohibition may be issued a ticket for \$1,150, required to pay an administrative penalty of up to \$10,000 or, if convicted in court, fined up to \$100,000 and/or sentenced to one year in jail. If the contravention causes or contributes to a wildfire, the person responsible may be ordered to pay all firefighting and associated costs.
