## Upper Jesse Creek wildfire under control

The Upper Jesse Creek wildfire, 8km north of town, grew minimally to 11.2 hectares yesterday before being declared 'under control'.

Fire behaviour is rank 1 & 2, ie. a smouldering ground fire with some visible, open flame and a slow rate of spread.

A small wildfire discovered nearby at Hector Creek on Monday, July 15, just before 5pm was actioned and declared out by Tuesday, July 16, at 10:45am. It had remained at 0.1 Hectares

Another fire sparked nearby at East Swakum Mountain on Monday was also declared out yesterday. It was mapped at 0.009 hectares.

## Valemount RCMP & Claire Newman's daughter appeal for public's help

Valemount RCMP are renewing its call for public assistance in solving a tragic hit and run incident that resulted in the death of Claire Newman on July 4, 2023, shortly before midnight. Despite exhaustive efforts by the RCMP and community, the person remains at large.

Lauren Newman, Claire's daughter, recently made a heartfelt plea on camera, urging anyone with information to come forward.

"Car accidents happen all the time. Things happen all the time. But that doesn't mean you can't do the right thing and come forward and give people the closure they need. If anybody knows anything or has any leads or tips, please contact the Valemount RCMP.

Sheldon Quewezance's 2nd annual Nicola Valley Bigfoot Conference will be held Sat, Aug 10 & Sun, Aug 11 at NVIT. Hear from experts, share your own encounter with other believers and visit our vendors for Sasquatch merchandise. Get ready for a day of mystery, excitement, and maybe a little bit of adventure.

The move to NVIT (from Shulus arena last year) means more people can be accommodated. "I'm expecting 300 people to attend per day but I have the capacity to accommodate 500 if necessary," said Sheldon.

This year, there are more guest speakers presenting over two days, instead of one. People are coming from around the province to take part in the event, with some speakers coming from the US to make presentations on a variety of topics surrounding the legend.
