DIY Air Cleaner
1x1 Building Instructions

Materials You Will Need

1 20x20" Box Fan (Rev. 75 Watts)
1 20x20" HEPA 33 Filter (FPM 200)
Cardboard Cut-out (From Fan Box)
Duct Tape
Scissors Or Box Cutters
Pencil Or Pen
Ruler Or Measuring Tape

Note: Use a new, clean fan in good condition.

- Take the fan out of its box.
Find the feet of the fan attached to the handle. Twist apart and forcefully slide into slots found on the bottom of the fan.
- Find the directional arrow on the side of the filter. Place arrow facing the back of the fan.
- Lay the fan face down.
Duct tape the filter directly to the back of the fan. Seal all sides thoroughly to prevent gaps.

Tip: The front of the fan includes the logo

Using Duct Tape To Make The Shroud

- Lay the fan face up on your desk.
Tape around the front of the fan, creating a border. Measure 2.5" from the outer edge of the unit on each side. Multiple strips of tape will be needed.
- Tape the corners of the front of the fan. Measure 5.3" from the outer edge.
- Add more duct tape as needed to close all gaps around the edges and corners.
- Personalize your air cleaner with stickers and decorative tape to make it uniquely yours.

What Is A Shroud?
The shroud stops air from being recaptured into the fan from the corners, which would reduce its effectiveness.

Stumbles Creek & Mount Thynne fires

Smoke was visible from a new fire above Craigmont Mine in Lower Nicola yesterday. It was discovered at approximately 6:30pm in the Stumbles Creek area, 17km northwest of Merritt. BC Wildfire Service said 2 personnel were on site as well as the local fire department. The fire was discovered just after 6:30pm and the cause is still under investigation. By the end of the day, BC Wildfire Service was reporting that it had brown to 0.6 hectares, and is burning out of control.

Another new fire 37km south of Merritt was discovered yesterday at Mount Thynne. It is estimated to be 3 hectares and the cause is under investigation.

Lightning Activity

The Kamloops Fire Centre recorded 1,118 lightning strikes from July 18 to July 23, as a result of thunderstorm activity. This lightning activity resulted in 59 new starts in the Kamloops Fire Centre since July 18, 2024.

When a new fire has been reported, the BC Wildfire Service conducts an assessment to determine priorities, and where resources will be deployed. Factors taken into consideration when coordinating response are a risk to first responders, human life and safety, values at risk, access and egress, rate of fire spread and weather conditions.
