Fire danger rating

The fire danger rating continues to waver between 'high' & 'extreme'.
The rating is set by the BC Wildfire Service. They advise: **High** – Prep your emergency kit and ensure you have a working plan that the whole family understands. **Extreme** – Pay attention to the City of Merritt, Voyent Alert!, local news, BC Wildfire Service, and other forms of communication regarding the ongoing fire situations in our area.

The ratings are updated on the Merritt Fire Rescue Department's Facebook page, as well as on-site at 1799 Nicola Ave. and Juniper Drive (across from Pineridge Cemetery).

Erosion protection for Claybanks & homes on Fir St.

One of the 17 'debris management' projects being worked on by the BC Govt, which resulted from the November 2021 Atmospheric River Event (ARE), is Claybanks, on the Coldwater River, approximately 200m downstream from the Middlesboro bridge.

Adjacent to the site, the river previously meandered along the right bank dike. During the ARE flood, the meander filled with sediment causing a channel avulsion to cut through the meander. At the site, the 'thalweg' — the line or curve of lowest elevation in a valley or watercourse, ie the deepest channel — was pushed to the base of the steep clay cliffs, increasing the risk of bank destabilization. The danger to public safety is that flooding, scour and rainfall will continue to undermine and erode the outer bank cliff, increasing the risk to the homes of residents on Fir Ave.

Bank failure, channel avulsion and sediment deposit are expected to reduce channel capacity, at least temporarily, and create additional risks both upstream and downstream.

Bank failure would result in deposits of fine-grained material, which would negatively impact fish habitat. Channel avulsion and sediment deposits would impact vegetation along the river, however it is anticipated that the vegetation would re-establish on its own.

The project consists of works to mitigate erosion and flooding risks along that stretch of the Coldwater River. It will address erosion and bank stability, implement works to protect the site from further erosion and land loss due to the river.

The total budget is \$9.4 million, projected completion date is December 2024. Project partners are the City of Merritt, Min. of Environment & Climate Change Strategy and Associated Engineering.
