**Permanent repairs to Hwy 8 begin soon**

Repairs to Highway 8 will begin soon to permanently restore the section approximately 15 kilometres east of Spences Bridge that was damaged by floods in 2021, and to enhance the highway's climate resilience.

The Province completed the procurement phase of the Alliance contract for Highway 8 and chose Aecon-Emil Anderson Construction General Partnership (AEGP) with their design partners, Urban Systems and Basis Engineering to complete this section.

Design work will start this summer with construction to follow. The project includes replacing 2 temporary structures with permanent bridges and building approximately 3 kilometers of connecting highway.

**Sunrise Expansion Project gas pipeline**

Westcoast Energy Inc. has applied to the Canada Energy Regulator (CER) for approval of their proposed Sunrise Expansion Program — approx. 137 km of 42-inch diameter natural gas pipeline, extending southwest of Chetwynd to the Canada-United States border near Sumas.

The expansion project includes several components: 11 pipeline looping segments alongside the existing Westcoast right-of-way, where practical; new compressor units at 4 existing compressor station sites; facility upgrades and other work at 11 existing compressor station sites; new piping and equipment at an existing meter station; and 3 new overhead power lines to power the electric-driven compressor units, which will total 34 km in length and will follow existing linear disturbances such as pipeline and power line rights-of-way and roadways.

One of the 3 the power lines is in the Merritt portion. The company proposes about 21 km of 138 kV overhead powerline from south of Merritt to compressor station 8A (CS-8A), north of Kingsvale.

Westcoast has also been undertaking environmental studies and engaging with Indigenous groups, landowners and other stakeholders to determine the best possible powerline routing.

If the Project is approved, construction is expected to begin the second quarter of 2026, with completion November 1, 2028.

Powerline construction is typically done during winter months, when the ground is firmer to limit extensive matting and environmental disturbance.
