Lightning-strike fires
The Kamloops Fire Centre recorded 1,037 lightning strikes from Aug 9-11, as a result of thunderstorm activity across the region. This lightning activity resulted in 30 new wildfire ignitions in the fire centre to date.

Thanks to the hard work of Initial Attack crews and support from aircraft pilots, of the 30 new starts, 2 are Being Held, 5 are Under Control and 18 have been called Out.

A fire discovered yesterday near Aspen Grove is 'being held' at 0.6 hectare. Two fires between Veale Rd. & Kane Valley Rd south of Merritt, as well as one between Prospect Crk & the headwaters of Spius Creek, remain 'out of control' though all remained under 1 hectare as of last evening. A fire discovered Saturday near Lindley Creek Rd is declared 'out'.

IIO gets new chief civilian director

Jessica Berglund has been appointed as the new chief civilian director (CCD) of B.C.'s Independent Investigations Office (IIO), the civilian-led police-over-sight agency responsible for conducting investigations into incidents of death or serious harm that may have been the result of the actions or inactions of a police officer, whether on or off duty.




Jessica was born in Merritt, growing up first on her family's cattle ranch in the Nicola Valley, before her family's move to the Okanagan.

She obtained her bachelor of arts in French and Asian studies from the University of Victoria, including studying at Beijing Normal University, before returning to Victoria to attend law school. Berglund was called to the bar in 1998 and practised civil litigation at Guild Yule LLP in Vancouver until 2002. She lives in Richmond with her husband and son.

Prior to her appointment with IIO, Berglund was the WorkSafeBC director of occupational health and safety investigations. She joined WorkSafeBC in 2003 where she held various legal and senior-management roles over a 21-year career.
