Proposed mixed use development for airport neighbourhood

A developer has applied to the City of Merritt to amend the zoning & OCP for their 2 proposed mixed-use developments, one at 3940 Crawford Ave., across the street from Boston Pizza, and the other directly adjacent — behind it — at 4079 Airport Rd.



The changes to the zoning & OCP are from 'Service Commercial' to 'General Commercial and Mixed Use', with a residential component.

A copy of the proposed bylaw amendments may be viewed Tues-Fri, 8am-12noon & 1:15-5:45pm at City Hall until Aug 27, or at merritt.ca

TNRD areas M & N fire protection survey results

With recent changes in fire protection service delivery in Electoral Areas "M" and "N" — including 772 addressed properties in Lower Nicola, Miller Estates, the north end of Coldwater Road, and areas east of Merritt, including Nicola Ranch and Harmon Estates — TNRD launched a survey. They say there was "good uptake in the survey" with 125 responses.

The majority of respondents were satisfied with the level of service and service costs. Over 80% rated the importance of fire protection as either "critical" or "important". Over 75% either agreed or were neutral on whether the tax rate of \$0.48 per \$1,000 of assessment was good value, and over 80% wanted the service to either stay as is or would be willing to pay higher taxes for enhanced service (i.e. a fire hall closer to their home).

Notably, the majority of respondents from Harmon Estates were dissatisfied with the service and service costs, contrary to responses from all other communities within the service area.
