Elderly missing Merritt man rescued

Just after 4pm last Thursday, a request was made for Kamloops Search and Rescue Rope Team Leaders to support Nicola Valley Search and Rescue to rescue an elderly man who had fallen down an embankment in a very remote location along Spius Creek.

The man had been missing for several days and was spotted by a group of ATVers. He had a broken hip and back injuries. A Medivac was able to land on a sandbar in the river and he was transported to hospital.

And the Boundary District Hospital in Grand Forks was closed due to limited physician availability, from 6am this morning, August 26 to 8am on Tuesday, August 27.
