Campfire ban rescinded today

With decreased temperatures, increased precipitation, higher relative humidity, and good recoveries overnight, Category 1 campfires will be permitted throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre, effective at 12 noon today Wednesday, August 28. This includes the use of chimineas and tiki and similar kinds of torches. Category 2 and Category 3 open fires remain prohibited until noon on Oct. 11, or until the orders are rescinded. And still restricted are: fireworks; sky lanterns; binary exploding targets; air curtain burners; and burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description, except when used for a Category 1 campfire as defined by the Wildfire Regulation.

Snow fell on 97C yesterday afternoon

DriveBC highway cams showed snow at high elevations on the Connector, between Kelowna and Merritt.

Environment Canada issued a special weather statement saying flurries were in the forecast for higher parts of the highway, lasting until early Tuesday evening.

"A trough of low pressure over southern Interior is bringing showers and a cooler airmass to the region," the alert reads. "With snow levels lowering to near 1,600 metres, showers have changed to flurries near Pennask Summit along the Okanagan Connector."

The weather agency warned drivers of "winter-like" driving conditions and reminded that mountain weather can change quickly and make roads hazardous suddenly.

Multiple crashes between Merritt & Kamloops

Multiple car crashes slowed traffic on the Coq, north of town yesterday.

Crews were dispatched to 3 crashes near Helmer Road just before 9:30am. Two of the crashes were called in at 9:22 am. One of the two collisions was cleared quickly. The third was reported as a vehicle rollover at 9:26am.

An air ambulance responded to one of the collisions believed to involve multiple vehicles including a semi truck. No report on injuries, but several people were transported to hospital.

The area was cleared by 11:30am. There are no weather alerts for the Coquihalla, though conditions between Merritt and Kamloops were reported as wet and slippery after a hail storm.
