Cat. 2 open burning prohibition rescinded

With a reduced fire danger rating in the Kamloops Fire Centre — because of widespread cooling temperatures and good overnight relative humidity recoveries, as well as the forecasted weather patterns — the category 2 open fires prohibition was rescinded on Wednesday.

In addition to cat. 2 open fires, equipment and activities that will no longer be restricted: fireworks; sky lanterns; binary exploding targets; air curtain burners; and burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description, except when used for a campfire as defined by the Wildfire Regulation.

Cat. 3 open fires remain prohibited.

E-petition to support federal disaster funding

The City of Merritt's Flood Mitigation team has launched a House of Commons e-petition calling on the Govt of Canada to support the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund (DMAF) or similar program to support small communities impacted by disasters.

The funding is critical for implementing a comprehensive dike system outlined in Merritt's Flood Mitigation Plan. And Merritt, along with Princeton, was frozen out of the program earlier this year — as a result of conflicting info from the prov. & fed. governments on the application process.

The petition gives residents, stakeholders, and supporters the opportunity to make their voices heard in Parliament. Once they reach 500 e-signatures, MP Dan Albas will secure time on the floor of the House of Commons to advocate on behalf of the community, affected by the 2021 Atmospheric River event.

Conayt funded for off-reserve housing

Conayt Friendship Society has received funding for 50 off-reserve homes (the address has not been yet been announced). More info about the project, amounts and timelines, will be made public as they are finalized.

The project is part of the Building BC: Indigenous Housing Fund (IHF) announced by the Province. This round includes 41 on- and off-reserve projects that will provide 1,662 affordable rental homes — 667 on-reserve homes for First Nations members and 995 off-reserve homes for Indigenous people.

The IHF is a \$1.7-billion provincial program, administered by BC Housing, to support government's target of delivering 3,500 homes for Indigenous families, elders, individuals and people with disabilities on and off reserve.

BC Housing is working closely with successful applicants, including Indigenous non-profit housing providers and First Nations, to continue these projects through the development process.

Operating agreements with off-reserve Indigenous non-profit housing organizations will be administered by the Aboriginal Housing Management Association (AHMA), the first for Indigenous/by Indigenous housing authority established in Canada. Its members manage more than 95% of all Indigenous-housing units located off reserve in BC.
