Special weather statement Strong wind gusts, heavy showers & maybe thunderstorms

Environment Canada has issued a special weather statement, for today: Late season thunderstorm potential with very strong wind gusts and locally heavy downpours, for Fraser Canyon, North and South Thompson, Nicola Valley, Similkameen, Okanagan Valley, Shuswap, Columbias, Kootenays, Yellowhead.

A vigorous cold front will cross the province on Wednesday bringing with it very strong winds aloft and an unstable airmass that is ripe for the development of strong wind gusts, heavy showers and potentially thunderstorms.

They warn of potential damage to buildings, such as to roof shingles and windows; high winds may result in power outages, and fallen tree branches; motorists, especially in high profile vehicles, may expect hazardous driving conditions on highways subject to strong cross winds; heavy downpours can cause flash floods and water pooling on roads; watch for possible washouts near rivers, creeks and culverts due to heightened risk of debris flows over areas impacted by burn scars.

Police continue to look for Sem Weiss

Williams Lake RCMP continue their efforts to locate Sem Weiss. They issued their first notice after an incident in Williams Lake on January 14, 2024.

Weiss, who is wanted for a home invasion and stabbing out of Williams Lake, is also wanted on a Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) on a Canada wide warrant for removal from Canada.

Police have since learned that he may be in the Merritt, area. Weiss should be considered dangerous and under no circumstances should you approach or try and apprehend him.

If you see Weiss, or have any info on his whereabouts, call 911 immediately.

Health for Good

Last week, Telus, in partnership with ASK Wellness Society, announced the launch of the newest Health for Good™ mobile health clinic that will bring primary health care and harm reduction services directly to people experiencing homelessness across the BC Interior.

Services will initially be provided in Kamloops and Merritt, with future plans to expand to Penticton. The announcement comes at a time when Kamloops, the 3d fastest growing city in Canada, is experiencing one of the highest rates of fatal overdoses per capita in BC, owing multiple factors, including the ongoing toxic drug supply crisis, a 51% increase in the number of people experiencing homelessness, and pressures on the health-system overall.

The ASK Wellness Mobile Health Clinic powered by TELUS Health will help address the urgent and increasing needs of these local communities, expecting to support over 4,000 patient visits/year.

“With increasing local demand, we’re thrilled to partner with TELUS to bring the mobile health clinic to communities across Kamloops and Merritt. This initiative enables our team to bring essential health care services directly to individuals who are in great need, removing some of the most common barriers to accessing healthcare, and ultimately helping improve the health and well-being of our local communities,” said Bob Hughes, Executive Director, ASK Wellness Society.


