Fraser-Nicola candidates

The Merritt & District Chamber of Commerce hosted an all-candidates meeting on Wednesday evening. Moderator Darcy McLeod put an entertaining game show host spin on his duties!

NDP candidate Francyne Joe is NV born-and-bred, recently returned to the valley, and wants to work for the communities. She sees that the riding needs more support for families (housing, daycare, healthcare, etc.), so that the economy can improve. She says jobs in trade, tech & health care need to continue growing, and her party needs the chance to keep their initiatives going — "they can't stop now!"

Green candidate Jonah Timms says building community is important, and continuing to build relationships with First Nations. He says his party can see things are changing and they'll make sure we move forward positively. Their platforms have reforms for health care, policies for economic growth — and in all sectors they see people being at the centre of the issues & solutions.

Conservative candidate Tony Luck says he will be proud to represent Fraser-Nicola riding (one of the largest ridings in the province), and help it and the province "get back on track". He says he'd address the rising crime by cutting all the local organizations including BC Housing & closing down "the facilities". He says to revitalize the economy, they'd want to get all the mills open again & the 17 mines awaiting approvals, get them operating. And he'd investigate IHA to be able to change the system.

General election day will be held on October 19. Voting cards are in the mail this week for polling station locations.

Community walk

On Thursday October 10, 9-11am, join City organizers for a community walk to the junction of the Coldwater & Nicola Rivers — land currently purchased or with signed agreements (along Pine St) through the GREEN ARDM (Adaptation, Resilience & Disaster Mitigation) grant stream.

This is an opportunity to explore the future site of the STUWI(x) Naturalization Project. You'll meet the STUWI(x) Steering Committee — made up of Elders, environmental stewards from local bands, and a City of Merritt community member — while learning about the extensive Indigenous consultations completed to date and the efforts to restore the natural river channel.

Starting at 9am, the event will open with a prayer, followed by remarks from community leaders and a guided tour of the site. The event runs until 11am, with refreshments. Everyone is welcome — bring your questions and enthusiasm!

If you can't make it to the walk, visit our project table at the City of Merritt Open House the evening before, where the Flood Mitigation Team will be available to answer your questions about this important pilot project.

Cat. 3 open burning prohibition rescinded

Effective at 12 noon today, Friday, Oct 4, category 3 open fires will be permitted throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre. This category includes: material concurrently in 3 or more piles each not exceeding 2m in height & 3m in width; material in 1 or more piles each exceeding 2m in height or 3m in width; one or more windrows, none of which exceed 200m in length or 15m in width; stubble or grass over an area exceeding 0.2 hectares. Local governments may still have their own burning restrictions in place. Always check with local authorities before lighting any fire of any size.
