## Final count in election wraps up today

This is the final day of the final count in last week's provincial election.

The final count involved 3 distinct processes: counting mail-in ballots, counting absentee ballots, and recounts of ballots counted on election night.

Saturday morning, they counted the mail-in ballots, which had been sent to an Elections BC counting facility in Victoria.

CTV News reported: "of the approx. 43,500 mail-in and assisted telephone ballots counted Saturday & Sunday, 55% went to David Eby's incumbent BC NDP, while just 32% went to John Rustad's BC Conservatives. The BC Greens took 10% of the votes, and the rest went to a mix of Independent and third-party candidates.

As of last evening, party standings remained the same as they did on election night, with the NDP leading in 46 ridings, the Conservatives leading in 45 and the Greens leading in 2.

Today, every electoral district across the province will conduct the final count process for any remaining absentee ballots starting at 9am. The number of ballots counted in each district during this part of the process will be small —approx. 1% of total votes cast. There are a number of different types of ballots counted at this stage, including mail-in voting packages dropped off at district voting places and DEO offices, special ballots (such as ballots cast by voters in hospital) and absentee ballots cast at voting places that did not use technology to administer voting.

Elections BC's website and social media channels will be updated once the final count process is complete.
